Padthaway is a renowned grape growing region in the Australian state of South Australia located within the Limestone Coast. There are now more than 4,000 hectares of vineyard planted with the red varieties Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon making up 50% of the total vineyard plantings in the region. The Potawurutj Aborigines named this place Padthaway meaning, 'Good Water'.

TASTING NOTE:

A full-bodied red wine, rich and silky with ripe blackberry and autumn fruit flavours, balanced with hints of chocolate and red plum. Typically Australian, this bold and opulent Shiraz with fruit sourced from Padthaway in South Australia, shows enticing dark fruit and vanilla spice characters, gently cloaked in fine soft tannins.

RECOMMENDATION:

This wine is perfect on its own or serve with Osso Bucco or mature, rich cheeses.
