Coonawarra is one of Australia's most internationally celebrated wine regions, located within South Australia's Limestone Coast. It is famous for its vivid red soil and world-class red wines due to its cooler maritime-influenced terra rossa soils. The Bindjali Aborigines named this place Coonawarra meaning "wild honeysuckle".

TASTING NOTE:

An elegant red wine with a rich and round palate full of dark fruit, liquorice and spicy oak. Juicy blackcurrant and wild blueberry characters are complemented beautifully by hints of tobacco spice. This Coonawarra Cabernet is framed by a soft yet lengthy finish.

RECOMMENDATION:

Serve at room temperature simply on its own or pair with a winter roast or spicy chicken and vegetable casserole.
